for the Province as listed in Listing Notice 3 of the 2014 EIA Regulations as amended. However, the levelling of the site for a sports field renders the site a disturbed area and therefore the vegetation currently found on the site cannot be described as indigenous.

The proposed project is therefore not a listed activity and an Environmental Authorisation is not required prior to commencement. Furthermore, the proponent is advised to adhere to the provisions of Section 28 of NEMA (Duty of Care) throughout the lifespan of the project.
