Good afternoon General and protocol observed.

- 1. This mail is for information on the meeting that was held at SAPS Tactical academy Moloto 2020-07-03 at 10:00
- 2. The meeting concern was about the basic assessment of the proposed quarry 4 associated with the upgrade of the National Road R 573 (Moloto Road) Gauteng Province.
- 3. The meeting was held at Moloto academy with the following role-players:
 - a. SANRAL Senior Environmental assessment Practitioner Me. Kirthi Peramaul
 - b. Lt. Colonel Serakwana of HRD Facility Management
 - c. Lt. Colonel Rademeyer, Lt. Colonel Matjeke and W/O M Kruger of Moloto Academy.
- 4. The meeting and inspection of Quarry 4 is for the purpose of upgrading of the Moloto Road.
- 5. The objective of visit and assessment of site is to obtain the Environmental Authorisation from the Component Authority Department Mineral Resources and Energy before activities could commence.
- 6. The visit aims to Identify and assess the environmental impact associated with the development and also provide alternatives to the development.

- 7. Notice was handed to SAPS Tactical Academy for the Public Participation Process of attended project and to notify the public of activities.
- 8. It is also mentioned that Engineers still need to visit Quarry 4 and meeting will be setup as soon as possible.

9. Concerns:

- a. During the meeting and visit of set Quarry 4, it seems that the Identified site where drilling took place for possible Quarry 4 and the proposed site indicated on map for project is not corresponding.
- b. The route to be used during the project is: from Moloto Road to Quarry 4 passes right next to the existing Administration building, safes, stores, fleet office, trainer accommodation, facility management office and range master's office.
- c. The main road leading up to the Quarry to be used will be used by learners, trainers and personnel during the day.
- d. Main road is used by trainees for different courses and members need to walk great distances during TRT, NIU Preparation Phases where trucks will be driving.
- e. Security Gate (Main Gate) will be used for all vehicle travel for heavy vehicle and day to day use by current contractors and the SAPS.
- f. Handling of security, vehicles and use of main gate of the academy, current structure and gate is to small / narrow for vehicle flow.
- g. Blasting that will take place during this project will probably damage the current borehole in use at the academy
- h. Borehole to be used for Quarry 4 is close to project site, but need to be equipped to function for the project.
- i. The borehole close to the site produces (WE THINK) +-4000 litre of water per hour but is not confirmed and the possible collapsing of borehole is possible during blasting.
- j. Shooting Range Complex 2 is in line with proposed project site.

10. During the meeting and site visit some proposals were put on the table concerning road use in the academy

- 10.1. Route to be changed to South Eastern side of the academy.
- 10.2. Project to get own Gate and security during project.
- 10.3. Confirming with Engineers and project Managers the correct site of Quarry 4.
- 10.4. Route traveling in Academy to be changed to assist and protect the Ecology and training members.
- 11. As per information it was also indicated that there will be meeting scheduled with the SAPS and the Project.
