Points Noted

- KP provided a background to the project explaining the need for Quarries. Public Participation will commence on the 3rd of July 2020. Due to the COVID 19 pandemic GA Environment requested the assistance of the Ward Councillor in terms of providing contact details of the landowners and I&APs.
- KP to provide CJW with a whatsapp of the notification letter for distribution to the ward committee members
- CJW advised that site notices can be placed at the Roodeplaat Spar, Wagendrift police station, dewagendrift supermarket, Wagendrift school, near big tree mall;

- CJW advised that previously he did receive complaints from residents in the area regarding the noise levels from the sand mining as these operations were operating 24/7. In terms of Quarry 4 there could be a large amount of job seekers.
