APPLICATION FOR WAY LEAVE: PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF THE WATER PIPELINE AND SERVICE CULVERT: PRIMARY ROAD P4/3: ROAD DISTRICT MATJHABENG

1. Your letter with reference no. 3299/2/1B06 dated 26 June 2018 refers.
2. The proposed water pipeline and service culvert crosses primary road P43/4 with a road reserve of 32 meters.
3. The Department grants approval for the installation of the proposed water pipeline and service culvert, as indicated on drawings nos. 3299B/LD/01, 3299B/PC/01 and 3299B/DC/07 submitted on behalf of Harmony Gold Mining, subject to the following conditions:
 - 4.1 The installation of the water pipeline and service culvert and the reinstatement of the road and road reserve must be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the Chief Engineer: Infrastructure, (Mr. T. Nkadimeng), Private Bag X 7, Winburg, 9420, (Tel: 051-8818209 and e-mail nkadimengt@freetrans.gov.za). He must be given at least (7) seven days written notice before commencement of the work.
 - 4.2 Permission to conduct excavations near services from other authorities such as Telkom, Eskom, Water Boards etc. in the provincial road reserve and/or building restriction area must be obtained from them to prevent any damage that may arise.

- 4.3 Traffic accommodation must be conducted as is indicated on drawing nos. 3299B/TD/O1, 3299B/TD/02 and 3299B-CD/01
- 4.4 The Department of Police, Roads and Transport shall not be involved in any expenditure in connection with the installation of the water pipeline and service culverts, any damage to the property of this administration or the reinstatement of the road reserve and shall not be responsible or liable for any financial or loss in the event of the Department of Police, Roads and Transport directing the removal or relocation of the water pipeline and service culvert if required as a result of road works or maintenance.
- 4.5 Harmony Gold Mining undertakes at all times to maintain the water pipeline and service culvert at own cost to take all necessary precautions to ensure the safety of the road users.
- 4.6 Harmony Gold Mining or its successors in title indemnities the Department of Police, Roads and Transport and Transport against any losses or damages suffered by any person or claims, including legal costs which may be instituted against the Department of Police, Roads and Transport as a result of the installation of the water pipeline and service culvert or any other works in the building restriction area of the public road, or as a result of the negligence of Harmony Gold Mining to maintain the water pipeline and service culvert or works properly, or as a result of any damage to the water pipeline and service culvert caused by whomever.
- 4.7 The Department of Police, Roads and Transport shall not be liable for any damage suffered by Harmony Gold Mining as a result of anything which may be done in connection with road construction and road maintenance or by any other action whatsoever.
- 4.8 The Department of Police, Roads and Transport reserves the right to direct the alteration or relocation of the water pipeline and service culvert at any time in the interest of public safety. The Department of Police, Roads and Transport may at any time rescinds, or amends any conditions under which the water pipeline and service culvert was authorized, or specify any further matter.
5. Permission to install the water pipeline and service culvert is granted in terms of the Advertising on Roads and Ribbon Development Act, 1940 (Act 21 of 1940) and the Roads Ordinance, 1968 (Ordinance 4 of 1968). Such permission, however, does not exempt Harmony Gold Mining from complying with any other legal provisions that may be applicable.
